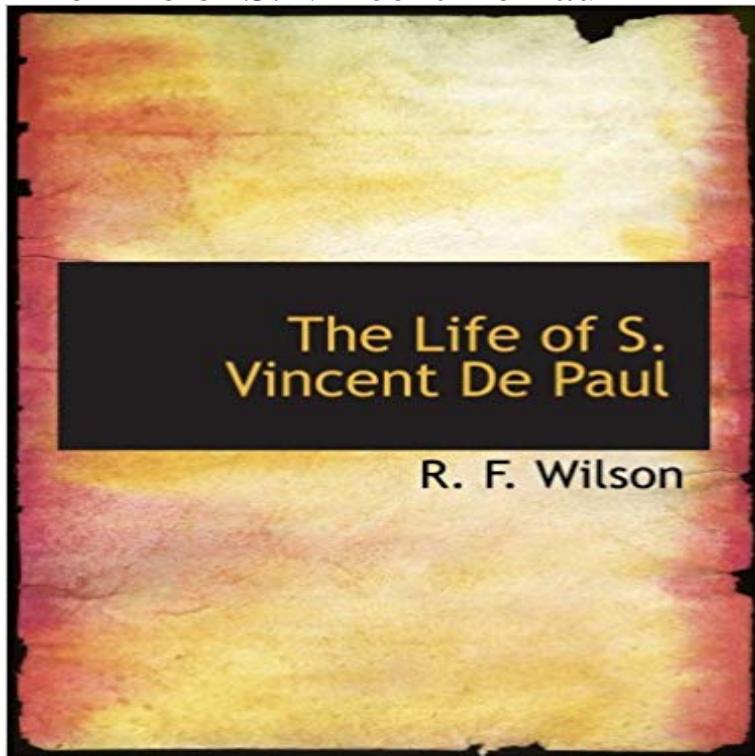


The Life of S. Vincent De Paul
