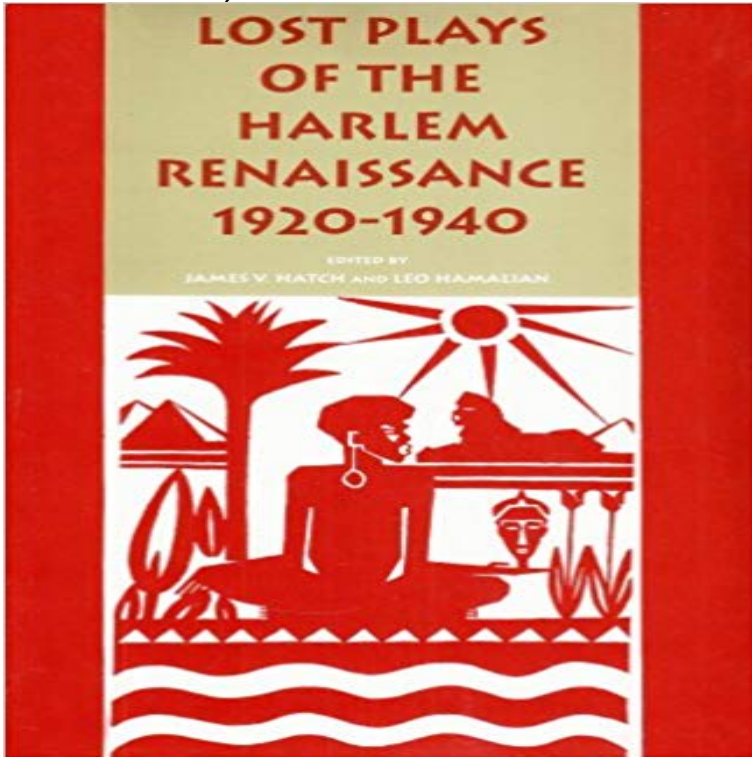


Lost Plays of the Harlem Renaissance, 1920-1940 (African American Life Series)
