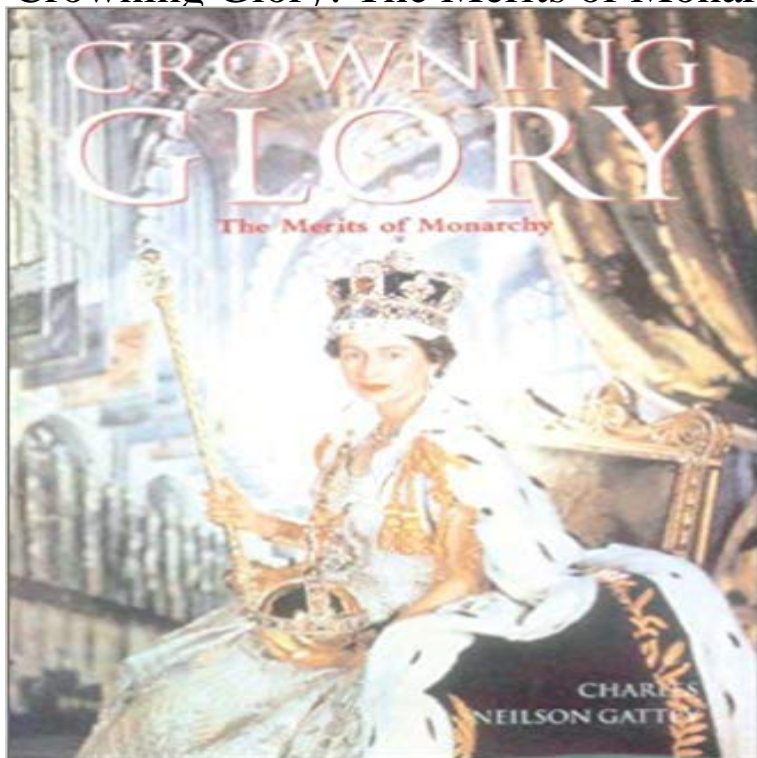


Crowning Glory: The Merits of Monarchy
